Prior to serving with Commissioner Welch, Kyle was a professional software engineer with a career spanning nearly a decade. Being only self-taught at first, he developed and released his first applications for iPhone in early high school. At the age of 19 while attending TCC, he was hired full-time as a programmer for Capital Health Plan, and later Aderant; two Tallahassee-founded organizations.

Kyle serves as a Board member of the Killlearn Lakes Plantation Homeowners Association, Chair of the Lawton Chiles High School Foundation Board, and Board member of Big Bend Cares/CarePoint.
