Major Sally Davis was raised in Ashland, Kentucky and moved to Tallahassee to attend Florida State University. She received her B.S. in Psychology from FSU in 1981 and a Paramedic Certification from TCC in 1984.

Davis has dedicated over 30 years to the public safety field. After receiving her Paramedic Certification from TCC, Davis held multiple roles with Tallahassee Memorial Hospital from 1984-2003. She presently serves with the Leon County Emergency Medical Services as Major over Special

Event Coverage Coordination and Community Engagement. In this leadership role, Davis oversees several programs and coordinates community events.

Her involvement with organizations like Honor Flight, Leadership Tallahassee, Make-A-Wish, and Second Harvest distinguishes Davis' career within her community and the larger public safety field. She has also been awarded with the EMS Injury Prevention Award and the Leon County EMS Community Service Award.
