Donna M. Uzzell retired as the Special Agent in Charge (SAC) of Statewide Investigative Services at the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE). In this capacity, she served as Florida's Homeland Security Advisor where she directly oversaw the Florida Mutual Aid, Cyber, and HighTech Units, Sex Offender and Career Offender Enforcement, and Missing Persons Clearinghouse and coordinated statewide Investigative Programs.

Previously, she served as the Director of Criminal Justice Information Services for 17 years. Her responsibilities included overseeing the establishment of Florida's Missing Persons Clearinghouse and Sexual Offender Registration Program and expanding the programs supporting the Criminal History File, Crime Information Center, and Firearm Purchase Program operation. Before that, she also served as Special Agent in Charge of the Investigative Support Bureau and spent 13 years with the Tallahassee Police Department.

Donna served on numerous national boards and committees, including the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact Council, FBI National Advisory Board, and was the Florida representative for SEARCH and the National Governor's Association Council of Homeland Security Advisors. She served eight years as an elected Leon County School Board Member and two years as Chairperson. In 2020, she was inducted into the Florida State Law Enforcement Officers Hall of Fame.
