



George Smyrnios

Trooper George T. Smyrnios is a hit and run investigator with the Florida Highway Patrol. He is assigned to Troop F in the Fort Myers district, where he oversees ten counties. Trooper Smyrnios graduated from the FHP Academy in 1993 and has served the state of Florida in Osceola, Madison and Lee counties. On average, has solved about 65 cases per year over the past 4 years. In 2019, Trooper Smyrnios solved 58 cases, making 19 felony arrest, 74 misdemeanor arrests, and 98 civil infractions.

Trooper Smyrnios, a graduate from Tennessee Temple University, holds two Bachelor of Science degrees. He is a member of the Summit Church in Estero, Florida where he serves as a leader in “Men’s Ministry”, and as a Pre-Marriage counselor with his wife. Trooper Smyrnios also preaches in several churches in his area as a guest minister. He also presides over weddings and funerals. Trooper Smyrnios is also a regular counselor at the annual Florida Boy State event in Tallahassee.

Trooper Smyrnios is an identical triplet. His two triplet bothers are also state troopers, serving in Lee and Taylor counties. His father is a retired Florida trooper from Taylor county. Between George, his dad and his two brothers, they have served the state of Florida for almost 110 years.

Trooper Smyrnios has been married to Angie Smyrnios for 29 years and has three children: Austin, Avery, and Alena. Angie currently serves as an administrative secretary at FHP in the Fort Myers CVE office.
