Grants and Contracts - TCC as Provider

Item Description:

This item requests that the Board approve the receipt of funding for the listed projects.

Overview:

The following are recommended for approval:

I. RECEIPT, AMENDMENT, EXTENSION OF RESOURCES

<u>Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Florida Law Enforcement Liaison (LEL)</u> Program

This award will provide personnel and other support related to the statewide LEL Program. The LEL Program promotes highway safety initiatives implemented by the FDOT Safety Office by increasing awareness, compliance, and law enforcement participation in traffic safety-related events. The amount of this award is \$1,519,627, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Florida DUI Challenge Program
This award will support the day to day activities related to the Florida DUI Challenge
Program. The DUI Challenge Program promotes the enforcement of driving under the
influence laws by providing public awareness and evaluating the effectiveness of the
program. The amount of this award is \$1,264,264, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The
funding period is from date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Florida Law Enforcement Challenge
This award provides an oversight for contractual services for the facilitation of the 2012
Florida Law Enforcement Challenge awards ceremony. This program provides
incentives and rewards to law enforcement officers and agencies that consistently
enforce traffic laws and offer a means of reducing dangers from traffic crashes. The
amount of this award is \$1,235,580, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding
period is from date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation - Professional Sports Marketing

This award provides an oversight of contractual services for purchasing paid media spots during professional sporting events to encourage sobriety and responsible driving. In addition, evaluation will be conducted to analyze the activated elements within each professional sporting venue. The amount of this award is \$1,950,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Major College Sports Marketing Program This award provides an oversight of contractual services for purchasing paid media spots during the sporting events of major colleges and universities to encourage sobriety and responsible driving. The amount of this award is \$532,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Impaired Driving Sports Campaign
This award provides an oversight of contractual services for purchasing media spots through cable television networks during professional televised sporting events to encourage sobriety and responsible driving. The amount of this award is \$216,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

<u>Florida Department of Transportation – DUI Statewide Media Campaign Labor Day</u> 2012

This award provides an oversight of contractual services to purchase paid media as well as pre- and post-campaign surveys during the National Traffic Highway Safety Administration (NHTSA) National Impaired Driving Labor Day Crackdown. The amount of this award is \$700,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from date of approval through 9/30/2012.

<u>Florida Department of Transportation – Florida Motor Unit Challenge</u>
This award will provide incentives to enforce traffic laws and to help with traffic safety

issues and safety belt enforcement. Funding will cover the expenses related to the Challenge, including travel, production cost and printing. The amount of this award is \$386,640, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation - Statewide Safety Belt Survey

This award will provides contractual services to coordinate and conduct safety belt surveys in several rural counties in Florida in accordance with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) requirements, which will measure the effectiveness of safety belt usage before and after specified measures have been implemented. The amount of this award is \$216,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Click It or Ticket (CIOT) Challenge Program This award will continue to expand the awareness and use of safety belts. This program will be utilized by working with local law enforcement agencies within the region of each law enforcement liaison. The amount of this award is \$564,840, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Click It or Ticket (CIOT) Paid Media Campaign This award will require the oversight of contractual services to acquire paid media spots during the 2011/2012 Click It or Ticket Mobilization waves to increase safety belt usage. The amount of this award is \$1,426,435, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Traffic Safety Staff Support
This award will provide an OPS staff assistant for the Safety Office to assist in processing financial paperwork and provide administrative support. The amount of this award is \$10,920, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Florida Impaired Driving Coalition
This award will bring technical groups and subject experts representing various disciplines to provide recommendations on critical issues related to alcohol-impaired driving. Issues to be covered are: legislation, adjudication, prosecution, enforcement, and new technology. The amount of this award is \$213,303, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – DUI Training Classes

This award will provide specialized training for law enforcement officers, prosecutors, civilian employees of law enforcement agencies and state employees of law enforcement agencies in Florida. The amount of this award is \$562,525, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation –Spanish Language Training for DUI Officers
This award will provide funding to implement a series of training programs at the
Florida Public Safety Institute (FPSI) designed to bridge the communication gap
between DUI officers throughout Florida and Latino motorist. The amount of this award
is \$250,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of
approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor Program This award will provide training for prosecutors and law enforcement officers in the legal, scientific and tactical aspects of DUI prosecution. The amount of this award is \$607,972, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – DUI Prosecution Support

This award is to provide the legal advisor staff support to the Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor in to assist with the coordination of the Alcohol Testing Program, which will provide DUI case related training to prosecutors in Florida. The amount of this award is \$178,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) – Pedestrian/Bicycle Staff Support
This award will provide a Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program Planner to be housed
at the FDOT Safety Office. The amount of this award is \$67,194, with an indirect cost
rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Police Traffic Training

This award will provide law enforcement officers with training in the areas of traffic safety, alcohol enforcement, and related programs. The amount of this award is \$500,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Traffic Records Coordinating Committee Support (TRCC)

This award will provide a part-time technical advisor to provide support to the TRCC Executive Board and its committees, as well as provide contractual services for the completion of the survey for the 2012 Annual report. The amount of this award is \$121,000, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Traffic Crash Reporting Form Workshop This award will provide training to law enforcement officers, non-sworn crash investigators, local traffic records personnel and agency/academy trainers on the requirements needed for completing the new Florida Traffic Crash Reporting Form. The amount of this award is \$50,850, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Transportation – Student Traffic Safety Program

This award will provide the coordination for the alcohol prevention activities at the college and high school levels. The amount of this award is \$145,477, with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from the date of approval through 9/30/2012.

<u>Florida Department of Transportation – Pedestrian and Bicycle Law Enforcement Training Program</u>

This award provides contractual services to increase the safety of pedestrian and bicyclist safety at crosswalks and intersection. Communication tools, such as interactive video clips will be created and disseminated to promote safety and pedestrian laws. The amount of this award is \$273,240 with an indirect cost rate of 8%. The funding period is from date of approval through 9/30/2012.

<u>U.S. Department of Labor – Florida Mine Health & Safety Training Program</u>
This award will help promote healthful workplaces for miners in Florida by assisting with training to prevent death and disease and to reduce the frequency and severity of injuries from mining related incidences. The amount of this award is \$271,000, with an indirect cost rate of 15%. The funding period is from date of approval through 9/30/2012.

Florida Department of Education – 21st Century Community Learning Center Project This award is to improve student achievement through after school and summer programs for at-risk students in Gadsden County attending Carter Paramore Academy and Havana Middle School. This will be achieved by establishing a community learning center, providing academic enrichment and cultural/recreational activities and engaging adult family members of students. The amount of this award is \$504,960, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 8/1/2011 thorough 7/31/2012.

Salient Facts:

The Board of Trustees has authority to contract with outside agencies for provider management.

Past Actions:

There has been no previous action by the Board on this funding.

Future Actions:

No further activity on the part of the Board is necessary.

Funding/Financial Matters:

The above projects will be established in Fund 2, Restricted Accounts. The indirect earned from these awards will be \$983,729.
