SUBJECT: Grants and Contracts - Provider

Item Description

This item requests that the Board approve the receipt of funding for the listed projects.

Overview and Background

The following are recommended for approval:

I. Receipt, Amendment, Extension of Resources

Florida Department of Education – Carl D. Perkins Postsecondary Vocational Education Program

This award is to provide direct student support services and job placement for disadvantaged/special needs students. This project helps to develop academic, career and technical skills of students who elect to enroll in career and technical education programs. The amount of this award is \$394,051, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 7/1/2014 through 6/30/2015.

Florida Division of Emergency Management - Mobile Home Retrofit Project

TCC will continue to serve as fiscal agent for fiscal year 2014 - 2015 for the Mobile Home Tie-down Program as described in Section 215.559 4(a) F.S., assisting administratively to implement the program. The amount of this appropriation is \$2,800,000, with an indirect cost rate of 5%. The funding period is from 7/1/2014 through 6/30/2015.

II. Commitments, Expenditures, Contracts for Services

Mobile Home Retrofit Project - Windstorm Mitigation, Inc.

TCC will require contractual services from Windstorm Mitigation to provide services for the mobile home tie-down program that will assist in securing manufactured homes to the ground. The amount of this contract is \$2,600,000. The contract period is from the date of approval through 6/30/2015.

Past Actions by the Board

There has been no previous action by the Board on this funding.

Funding/Financial Implications

The above projects will be established in Fund 2, Restricted Accounts. The indirect earned from these awards will be \$152,097.
