Fall 2020 In Review

Takeaways

- As part of our CARE initiative and due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the College implemented strategies designed to provide early, intentional and embedded support; for example, Learning Commons specialists and librarians were embedded into core first-year courses in fall 2020.
- As a result of these and other strategies as well as the diligent work of our faculty and staff, overall course success rates increased by nearly 3%, and first-time-in-college (FTIC) student success rates increased by 8.3% in fall 2020.
- Spring 2021 will feature embedded services and outreach similar to the fall. Course offerings will also be similar with 51% of for-credit class sections are being offered LIVE, 33% online, and 16% will be in-person/hybrid.

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
