Course Description:

This 3-day course is designed to train armorers to maintain, inspect and repair the AR -15 Rifle. Students will learn the necessary skill sets required to inspect and repair the AR-15 Rifle and perform an armorer's duties.

This is a general course that will give the officer the ability to service any direct impingement AR-15 (most brands) and some piston driven AR-15's. We do not focus on one brand. If the student wishes they can bring their depart-ment issued rifle and any proprietary components can be discussed,. Additionally, I encourage students to bring any broken firearms from their department to diagnose for repair. If you would like any references please feel free to ask.
