

FDLE Sniper School

Course Description:

The school is a consecutive 10-day course designed to prepare tactical officers to fulfill the role of a law enforcement sniper for their agency. Training topics include but are not limited to:

- Precision Marksmanship Skills at close, medium and long-range distances.
- Overwatch and Counter Sniper Operations, Rural, Urban and Vehicle Fieldcraft
- Observation and Scouting Techniques, Operational Planning and Execution
- Rifle Data Collection and Application of Ballistics, Stressed and Positional Shooting
- Equipment Selection, Nomenclature and Maintenance
- Target Construction and Barrier Mitigation

Law enforcement officers are invited to attend the course <u>free of charge</u> provided they meet the below requirements:

- Active member of a law enforcement agency SWAT Team, Special Operations Team, Etc. (signed agency letterhead required for registration).
- Assigned to a sniper position on their team or will be fulfilling that role upon completion of the course.
- Physically capable of traveling long distances on uneven terrain while carrying operation related equipment.
- Physically capable of maintaining uncomfortable body positions for extended periods of time and operating at elevated positions.
