

## CHECKLIST FOR APPLICANTS TO THE RN to BSN PROGRAM

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. **COMPLETION OF AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAM OR DIPLOMA PROGRAM IN NURSING FROM AN ACCREDITED NURSING SCHOOL OR COLLEGE.**
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. **COMPLETION OF THE TSC NEW/RETURNING STUDENT APPLICATION OR CHANGE OF PROGRAM OBJECTIVE (current students).** Contact TSC's Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services to obtain information on the college admissions process and/or to change your program objective.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3. **COMPLETE THE DIVISION OF HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS APPLICATION FOR RN to BSN.** Submit the completed application in this package to the Division of Healthcare Professions at the address on the application. Attach to the application packet, copies of the documents requested in items 4-5 below.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 4. **PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION OF CURRENT RN LICENSURE WITH NO RESTRICTIONS.** The current license must be active in the state where your professional nursing practice is located and a copy must be submitted with the RN to BSN application packet.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. **PROVIDE OFFICIAL HIGH SCHOOL, VOCATIONAL SCHOOL & COLLEGE TRANSCRIPTS.** Applicant must request that official transcripts from high school or GED (scores required) **and** all colleges attended be sent to **TSC's Office of Admissions and Enrollment Services** for evaluation by the program application deadline. Copies (unofficial are sufficient) of all college/university must be submitted with the RN to BSN packet.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. **DOCUMENTATION OF A GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) OF 2.00 OR HIGHER IN ALL COLLEGE CREDIT COURSES AND A "C" OR HIGHER IN ALL PREREQUISITE COURSES APPLICABLE TO THE RN TO BSN PROGRAM.**  
Note: All other course requirements (any course without an NUR prefix) must be completed prior to beginning courses at the 4000 level.
